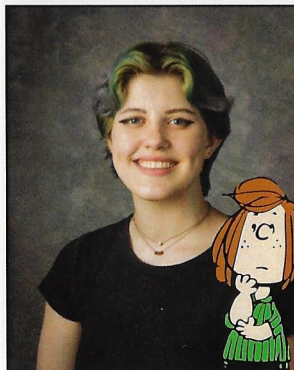
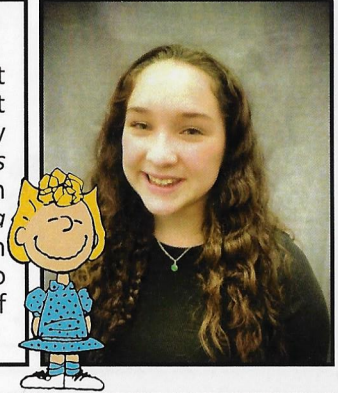
GIANPIERO CAVERO ALACRON (CHARLIE BROWN)

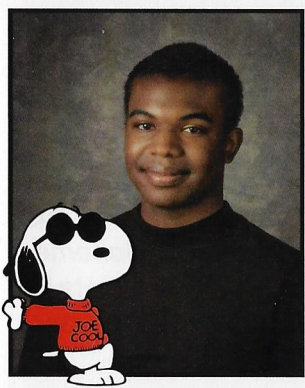
ISABELLA VEGA (SALLY BROWN)

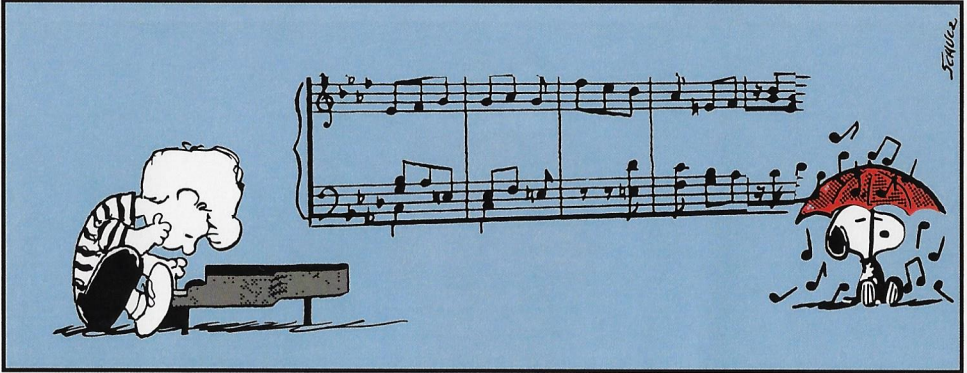
MIA ANDREATTA (PEPPERMINT PATTY)

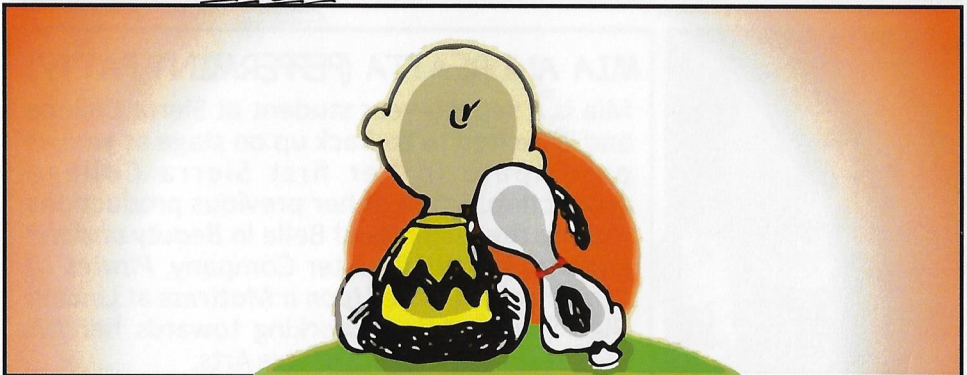
KAMERON CALLOWAY (SNOOPY)

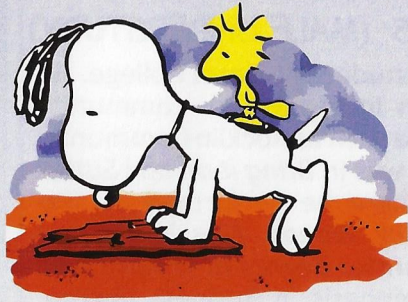
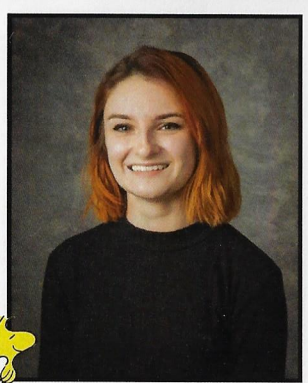
CARLY PLAGEMAN (LUCY VAN PELT)

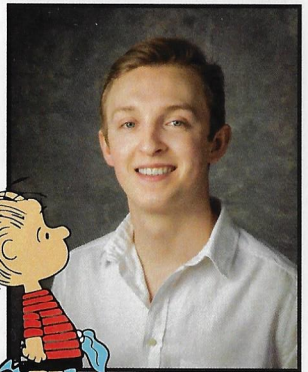
MORGAN CRENSHAW (WOODSTOCK) (FEMALE UNDERSTUDY)

FABIAN TUDOR CARUNCHO (LINUS VAN PELT)

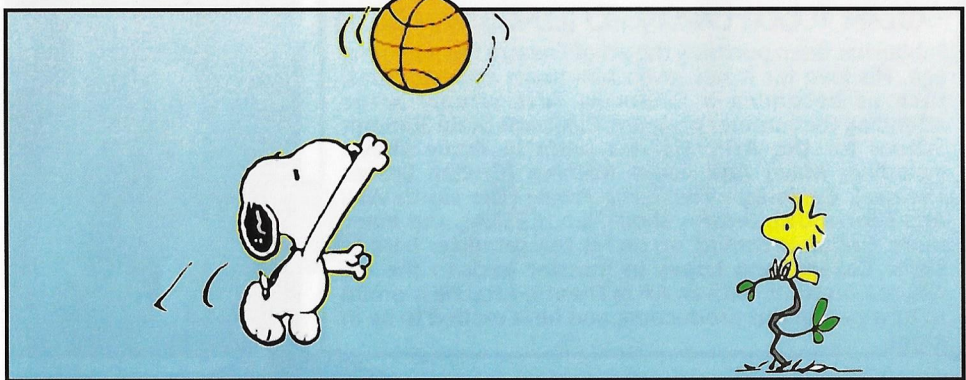

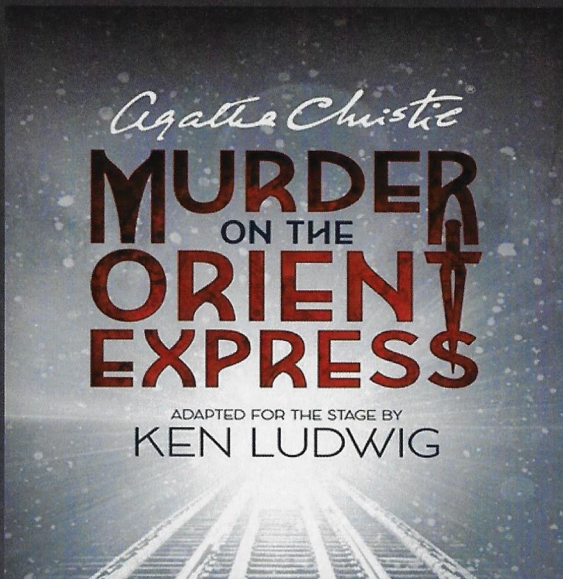
