'ROUND MIDNIGHT has been thrilling audiences for over a decade. The quartet is a six-time Semi-Finalist in the BHS (Barbershop Harmony Society) International Barbershop Quartet Contest and they are past BHS Mid-Atlantic District Quartet Champions. The group has received praise for their recording efforts too, garnering multiple Contemporary A Cappella Recording Award (CARA) nominations in the categories of "Best Barbershop Album" for their most

recent collection entitled, "New York State Of Mind" and "Best Barbershop Song" for their renditions of "Nothing Can Change This Love" and "Try A Little Tenderness".



Dubbed "The Barbershop Gateway Drug" by Contemporary A Cappella guru Deke Sharon (Music Director, "Pitch Perfect" and "Pitch Perfect 2"), 'Round Midnight was voted "Favorite Barbershop Quartet" by the membership of CASA—The Contemporary A Cappella Society. The foursome won the New York City Harmony Sweepstakes Championship and was given

the coveted "Audience Favorite" award by overwhelming crowd vote. In addition, the quartet was appointed an official "Arts Envoy" by the U.S. State Department and they have conducted master classes on barbershop harmony for students of all ages from Kindergarten through University in the United States, Canada, and Europe.

While living in New York, he was the Musical Director of three barbershop choruses. Wayne is a highly sought barbershop arranger and is the primary arranger for 'Round Midnight.

Jeff is a Five Towns College alumnus with Bachelor's and Master's degrees, both in Music Education. He is an elementary school classroom/choral music teacher on Long Island, NY. Jeff is currently the Musical Director of the Long Island Sound barbershop chorus and its scholastic offshoot, the Five Towns College collegiate barbershop program (the only barbershop chorus in the world offered for college credit). In addition, he has been a featured vocalist with "New York's Most Dangerous Big Band."

In July 2014, they placed 16th in the International Quartet Contest and received the Dealer's Choice Award for being the highest scoring debut quartet of the year. 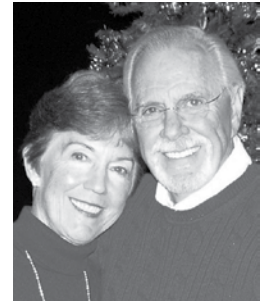

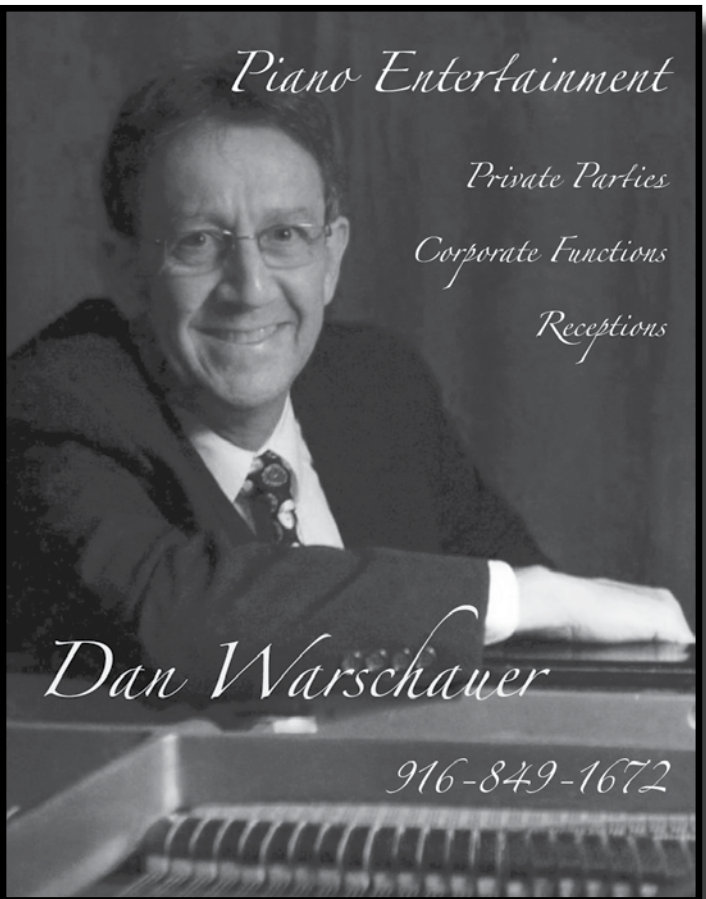

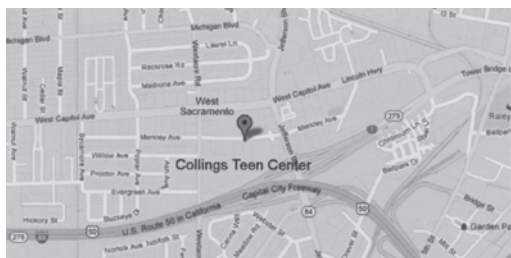

Voices of California ~ Director

Gabe Caretto was first introduced to barbershop harmony in 1986 by his high school music teacher, and has been actively performing in both choruses and quartets ever since. A classically-trained musician, Gabe received a Bachelors degree in Music from Southern Oregon State College and a Masters degree in Music Education from the University of Oregon. Before changing careers, he directed the highly successful vocal music program at Meridian High School in Meridian, Idaho, for seven years.



He has been a member of two quartets that have been named champions of the Far Western District (FWD) of the Barbershop Harmony Society (BHS). The 2006 champions, *Late Show*, placed as high as 12th in the world at the annual BHS International Convention. His current quartet, *Artistic License*, was the 2011 Far Western District champion and has consistently placed in the top 15 at the BHS International Convention the past several years.

Gabe has directed barbershop choruses in Oregon, Idaho, and California since 1989. For four years, he studied under Dr. Greg Lyne as Assistant Director of the Bay Area's *Voices in Harmony*, the 2008 International bronze medalist chorus.

Over the past 27 years, Gabe has served in a variety of leadership positions and educational roles for the Barbershop Harmony Society, including serving on the faculty of Harmony University in St. Joseph, Missouri. He is currently the Dean of the Northern California Youth Harmony Camp and is a sought-after coach for choruses, quartets, and youth workshops and festivals throughout the northwest and California.

Gabe is one of the founding members of the award winning **Voices of California**, and has served as their Music Director since its inception in January 2010.
