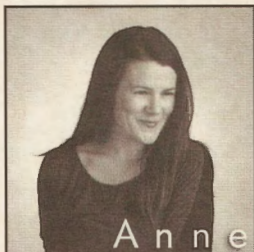

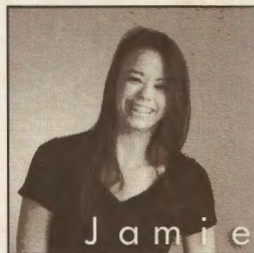

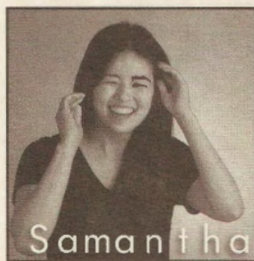

Director's Note


Friends of CORE,

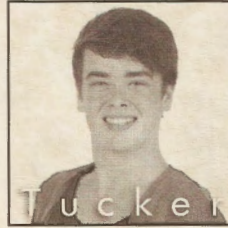
